



KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

South Africa is home to some of the best national parks in the world for photographic tours. At the very top of the list is the famous Kruger National Park. This 2 Million Hectare park, home to an astounding abundance of fauna and flora, boasts some of South Africa's best game viewing. You'll never know what photo opportunity awaits around the next corner.

Accommodation options for the park are quite numerous and range from ultra-luxurious to very basic. The major attractions are the great number and variety of archaeological sites; San art sites; game and Big Five experiences; unusually large examples of numerous trees including baobabs and climbing figs; scenery; "moon landscapes" of sandstone formations; bird life; eco routes and "three country" experiences.

CHOBE SAFARI LODGE

Duration: 3 days, 2 nights Minimum of 2 clients

Chobe Safari Lodge, located on the banks of the Chobe River in northern Botswana, is the best destination for serious game viewers. The Park is home to over 80 000 elephants as well as numerous herds of buffalo. There are plenty to choose from when it comes to food venues. The Sedudu Bar, overlooking the Sedudu Island in the Chobe river, is the place to unwind with a sundowner.

Of all the activities offered (including mokoro safaris, guided walks, game drives, fishing, birdwatching and visits to the Xaxaba village), the helicopter flight over the Okavango Delta is surely the highlight.

While it is neither the highest nor the widest waterfall in the world, it is classified as the largest, based on its width of (5,604 ft) and height of (354 ft), resulting in the world's largest sheet of falling water.

Victoria Falls is roughly twice the height of North America's Niagara Falls and well over twice the width of its Horeshoe Falls. In height and width Victoria Falls is rivalled only by Argentina and Brazil's Iguazu Falls.

ACTIVITIES AT CHATTARONGA

MORNING & SUNSET GAME DRIVES

Game drives are done in open 4x4 game drive vehicles by well trained guides. Regular sightings of Rhino, Buffalo, Sable antelope, Zebra, Gemsbok, Kudu, Giraffe, Impala, Eland and Blue Wildebeest. Morning drives are about 3 hour and starts at 7am.

NIGHT DRIVES

Night drives are offered after dinner. Night drives are very popular, where we concentrate on nocturnal animals only. Aardwolf, small spotted genet, and a very good chance to see the elusive aardvark, various rodents, owls make for an unforgettable game drive, not to mention the starstudded night sky.

BIRD & GAME VIEWING

Bird & game hide overlooking a water hole, which is an excellent location for photography and general game viewing.

FISHING

Fishing for the legendary species of bream, barbel (catfish), yellowfish, squeaker and mackerel not only provides an exciting fishing experience, but excellent game viewing (crocodile, hippo) and birding as well. Equipment is provided, and a knowledgeable guide is on hand for all expeditions. Fishing is done by boat positioned near banks and mid-river reads. The fishing is done at the Magalakwena River Lodge, part of Chattaronga Safaris, about 20 min. drive from the Chattaronga's Baobab Lodge.

FORMALITIES

A valid passport is needed to enter any of the countries that we hunt in. South Africa does not usually require a Visa. However some countries do require a visa to enter Zimbabwe, most of the time these can be obtained at your port of entry into Zimbabwe.

CITES PERMITS

Certain animal species will require a CITES (Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species) permit for the import of the trophy into your country of origin. We do not recommend applying for the permit before you have harvested your desired trophy, after your safari you can apply as you will then have the required documentation required from Chattaronga in order to apply for your CITES permit.

INSURANCE

In the unlikely event of a hunting accident and/or need for emergency evacuation, Chattaronga recommends Global Rescue – the number one trusted partner for evacuation during hunting accidents. Visit their website at www.globalrescue.com.

Our firearm insurance is handled by Hollis E. Boss of Sportsman's Insurance Agency, Inc. (SIAI) 800-925-7767. They insure guns, bows, cases and related items such as scopes, rings, quivers, sights, etc.

We suggest that you arrange for general travel insurance through your credit card provider when booking your trip.

FEES INCLUDE:

- · Accommodation, including full board
- Liquor and beverages served in camp (Wine, Beer & Soft Drinks)
- Laundry
- Full-time service of an experienced Professional Hunter. Trained staff, trackers and skinners
- Field preparation of trophies. All transport within the hunting areas. All hunting licenses
- Pick up and drop off at International Airport closest to the area in which you are going to hunt
- VAT Taxes on Day Rates

FACILITIES

We have a fully-equipped rifle and bow shooting range, ideal for preparing yourself and your equipment for the hunt.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A 50% deposit of total safari is payable upon confirmation of booking. Outstanding balance is payable within 2 weeks. Internet banking/credit card facilities is available in South Africa and Zimbabwe. Deposit will not be refunded if safari is cancelled nine months or less prior to commencement. Booking may be postponed to an alternative date without a penalty until the next calendar year. Any further cancellation regardless of notification period results into a 100% forfeit.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you cancel more than six months prior to the hunt, you are entitled to 50% of your deposit refunded; cancellation less than six months prior to your hunt results in deposit being forfeited. Or, your deposit may be carried forward to the next calendar year without penalty. Cancellation in subsequent year will result in complete forfeit.

WOUNDED ANIMAL POLICY

A wounded animal is regarded as a shot animal, and the full trophy fee will apply.

Concealment is an integral part of the art of game hunting. Knowing which blind, hide or pit to use varies by the hunter's physical ability or disability, by bow or by rifle, by bait, by species, by season, by location. Whether at ground level, below ground level or from above at tree level,





HUNTING REGULATIONS

The Tanzanian Wildlife Department regulations permit the hunting of both lion and leopard under the following conditions only:

- · 21 Day Safari
- · 1 x 1 One Lion and Leopard permit
- · 2 x 1 The clients must share one Lion and one Leopard permit
- · 2 x 2 Each client will have one Lion and one Leopard permit
- · 3 x 2 The client will share two Lion and two Leopard permits

The Tanzanian Wildlife Department minimum length regulations are:

- The minimum legal length for Leopard is 1.50 meters (60 inches) from tip of nose to base of tail.
- The minimum legal length for Elephant is 1.60 meters (62.99 inches) of tusk or 18 kilograms weight (39.6 pounds).
- The minimum legal length for Crocodile is 3.00 meters (118 inches) from tip of nose to tip of tail.
- Minimum caliber for dangerous games is .375 (9.3 mm). Handgun hunting is strictly forbidden.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

- A deposit of 50% of safari rate is required to confirm the booking.
- Game Trophy Fee and all Government royalties charged would be those applicable to the year the safari is taken regardless of what is quoted in the initial contract.
- Invoices and quotes are subject to charge at any time based on any changes in Government Fees, Taxes or Game Trophy Fees, which are out of our control.

INSURANCE
